NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/19/2003-P&AR(GSW), the 12th November, 2003. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post(s) of Primary School Teacher under Education & Human Resources Development Department (School Education), Government of Mizoram, namely:-

| Short title and commencement | 1. (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Education & Human Resources Development Department (School Education) (Group 'C' post) Recruitment Rules, 2003. |
| | (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette. |
| Application | 2. The Rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto annexed. |
| Number of posts, Classification and scale of pay. | 3. The number of the said post (s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the First Schedule as aforesaid. |
| Method of recruitment, Age limit and other Qualification. | 4. The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the First Schedule aforesaid. |

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Government of Mizoram from time to time.

Disqualification 5. No person—

- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post (s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these Rules.

6. Every Government servant recruited under these rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest shall have the right and power to transfer any officers so recruited under these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
8. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
9. Nothing in these Rules shall affect any reservations or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Govt. or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
10. All the Rules pertaining to the recruitment to these posts still in force issued under Notification No. A. 12018/53/80-APT(B) dt. 15.10.1996 and No. A.12018/53/80-APT(B) dt. 8.7.1998 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Issue No. 396 dt. 24.10.1996 and Issue No. 129 dt. 13.7.1998 are hereby repealed.
