NOTIFICATION

12018/53/80-APT(B)/, the 25th October, 1988. In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, The Government of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the post of Graduate Hindi Teacher, High School/Mizoram Hindi Training Institute/Special Hindi School, Laboratory Bearer, Guide Lecturer, Mizoram Museum, Primary School Teacher under Education & Human Resources as follows:-

1. These Rules may be called the Mizoram Education & Human Resources (Group 'C' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1988.
2. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
3. The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 to the Annexure I aforesaid.
4. The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Annexure - I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Govt. or Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.

5. Disqualification : . No person,
a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living.
b) Who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person

or
shall be eligible for appointment to the posts.

Provided that the Governor may exempt any person from the operation of these rules if he is satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the provisions of the law applicable to such person and the other provisions of the law relating to marriage and that there are other grounds for exempting any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Training and Departmental Examination : Every Govt. Servant shall undergo such training and such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

7. Power to relax : Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and subject to the conditions to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Selection Board, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

8. Reservation, other concessions : Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in Mizoram in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

9. Repeal and Saving : All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Assam or by the Govt. of Assam and which were in force in the erstwhile Mizo District and continued to be in force in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification No. 14/21/71-HMT (ii) dt. 21.4.1972 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or any action taken under the rules so repealed or any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
