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NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/52/80-APT (B), the 29th August, 2000. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the Post of Despatch Rider in various Offices under the Government of Mizoram, namely :-

1. Short title and Commencement. (i) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Despatch Rider (Group 'C' post) Recruitment Rules, 2000.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application. The Rules shall apply to the post specified in Column 1 of the Annexure-1 hereto annexed.
3. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of pay. The number of the said post (s), their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 - 4 of the Annexure-1 aforesaid.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications. The age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 14 of the Annexure - 1 aforesaid.
Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Govt. of Mizoram from time to time.
5. Disqualification. No person—
 - a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
 - b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post (s).

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of these rules.

6. Training and Departmental Examination. Every Government servant recruited under these Rules should undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. Power to transfer. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Governor of Mizoram in public interest shall have the right and power to transfer any officer so recruited under rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
8. Power to relax. Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing in consultation with the Department of Personnel and Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions to these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
9. Reservation and other concessions. Nothing in these rules shall affect any reservations or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Tribes/ Scheduled Castes and other categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regards.
10. Repeal and Savings. All Rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Assam or Governor of Assam and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of in Home Affairs' Notification No. 14/21/71-HMP dated 21.1.1972 or framed by the Govt. of Mizoram under Notification No, MAP/ B/ 14/72-73/10 dt. 19.3.1975 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Issue No. 11 dt. 21.3.1975 are hereby repealed.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the Rules so repealed or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.
