Dated Aizawl, the 27th May, 1981.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-HM(11) dated the 21st January, 1972 and all other powers enabling him in this behalf the Administrator of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating to the recruitment to the posts of Primary School Teacher under Education & Social Welfare Department of Government of Mizoram, namely :-

1. Short title and Commencement.
 - 1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Education & Social Welfare Department (Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1980.
 - 2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. Application.

These Rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereto annexed.
3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.

The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Column 2 to 4 of the Schedule aforesaid.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualification.

The age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Column 5 to 13 of the said schedule.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government of Government of Mizoram from time to time.

Qualification

No person :

a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living,

b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Administrator may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

Training and Departmental Examination.

Every Government servant shall undergo such training or pass such departmental examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

Power

Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Reservation in other concessions.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation or other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

Repeal

All Rules pertaining to these posts issued by the Governor of Assam or by the Government of Assam and were in force in the erstwhile Mizo Dist. and continued to be in existence in pursuance of Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/21/71-EM (I) dated 21.1.1972 and post at sl. No. 15 of the Schedule attached to Government of Mizoram, Education & Social Welfare Department Notification No. 40/74-75/36-41 dated 10.4.1975 published in the Mizoram Gazette on 20.2.1976 Issue No. 8 are hereby repealed.

FOOTNOTES:

The crucial date for determining the age limit mentioned under Col. 6 of the Sectt. will, in each case, be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (other than Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep). In respect of the posts, the advertisement to which are made through the employment exchanges, the crucial date for determining the age limit will, in each case, be the last date upto which the employment exchanges are asked to submit the names.

Demerits:

- i) Trained B.S.L.C. passed with adequate Teaching experience.
- ii) Written knowledge of Hindi/Local language upto Middle School standard is desirable. It may be relaxed in case of candidates belonging to Chandigarh District.
